

Hidden Trails Grand Slam Tournament

Tournament information:

- Please arrive 30 min before your first round scheduled match play time. We will go over tournament rules and take team pictures before your first round. Please bring sunscreen, matches will be played indoor and outdoor.
- Masks are required in the lobby area (if you need one we will provide masks at the front desk).
- 2.5 and 3.0 flight match time: 9-1pm
- 3.5/4.0 and 4.5+ flight match time: 2-6pm

Tournament rules:

- Team matches will consist of one set each of men's and women's doubles and one set of mixed doubles, for a total of three sets within each team match.
- **Each set will consist of a total of 8 games.** (Example: set score can be 6:2, 5:3, 8:0,...)
- The games will be no-ad scoring. If a game score reaches 3 points each, the deciding point will be served gender-to-gender in mixed doubles, or receiver's choice of ad or deuce court in men's or women's doubles. If a score is 4:4 in a set, you will play out a regular 7 point tiebreaker.
- We will have score keepers at the courts so please make sure to update the score after each game.
- **Let rule: If you serve and it's a "let", the opponents have to play it out. Either partner may return the let serve.**
- Please make sure to report your final score to the tournament desk.
- If the two teams have won an equal number of games, the mixed doubles tiebreaker will be played – tiebreaker will be first to 7 points by a margin of 2 to decide the team match. The tiebreak counts as one game in the final total.
- A team may at any point, excluding the tiebreak, substitute a player (same gender) into a set for any reason. Once a player is replaced, he/she cannot return in that set. If a substitution occurs, the remaining player cannot change either the service order, or the side on which he/she receives.
- The winner of each flight will be the team with the greatest number of total games after all three rounds are completed. If there is a tie, the winner will be determined by the head-to-head performance of the teams tied for the title. Each player on the winning team will receive a tournament reward.
- And the most important rule of all: **Have Fun!**
